vaccine clinics for Redding are being held (by appointment
only) for all who wish to receive it. The vaccination is free.

Current surveillance data indicates the influenza-like illness
activity is at normal levels for this time of the year. A third
wave of illness could occur in the coming months.
Vaccination is the most important step in protecting against
H1N1 flu.

It is recommended that all parents who have children with
flu-like illness to keep them home until they are symptom
free for 24 hours.
